Instructions for displaying your photos and videos in Canvas

While we are working online, I will be asking you post your work to Canvas so we can share with each other and have online discussions.

Photos and Video are handled differently. It's a bit confusing the first time you do it, so please ask if you have trouble.

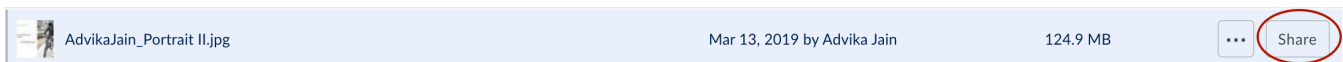

FOR PHOTOS

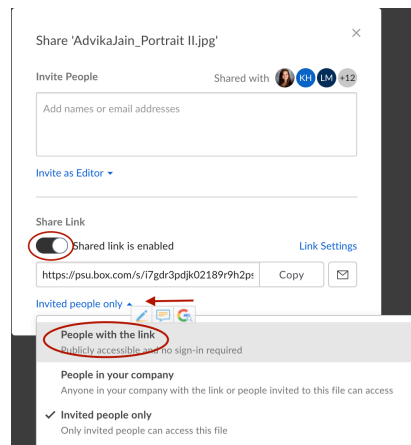
You already know how to get your photos to Box. That's the first step.

To embed a photo in Canvas from Box you need the **direct link** from Box. This is a bit tricky until you learn how. (** The image MUST be a jpeg**)

1. Find the photo in your Box folder and click **Share**
(The photo must be in your folder in Box, NOT the class upload folder)



2. Select the Share Link button and change the dropdown to "People with the link".



3. **DON'T USE THE LINK YOU SEE!** Click **Link Settings**.

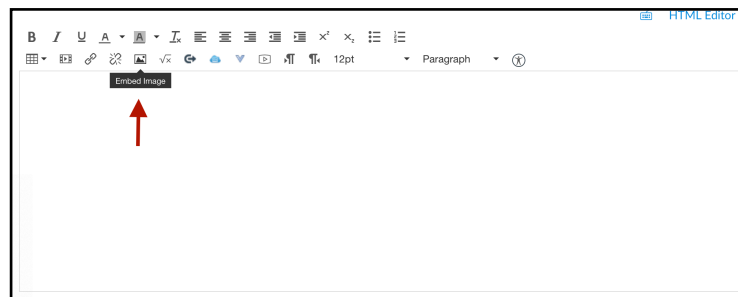
4. USE the **Direct Link** in the Link Settings



5. Finally, In Canvas, in the discussion, use the embed button to place the image in your post.

6. Paste the Direct Link from Box into the URL field. Change the first dimension to 800 and click Update.

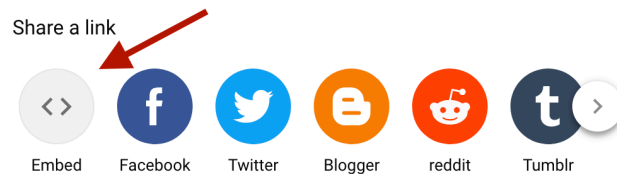




